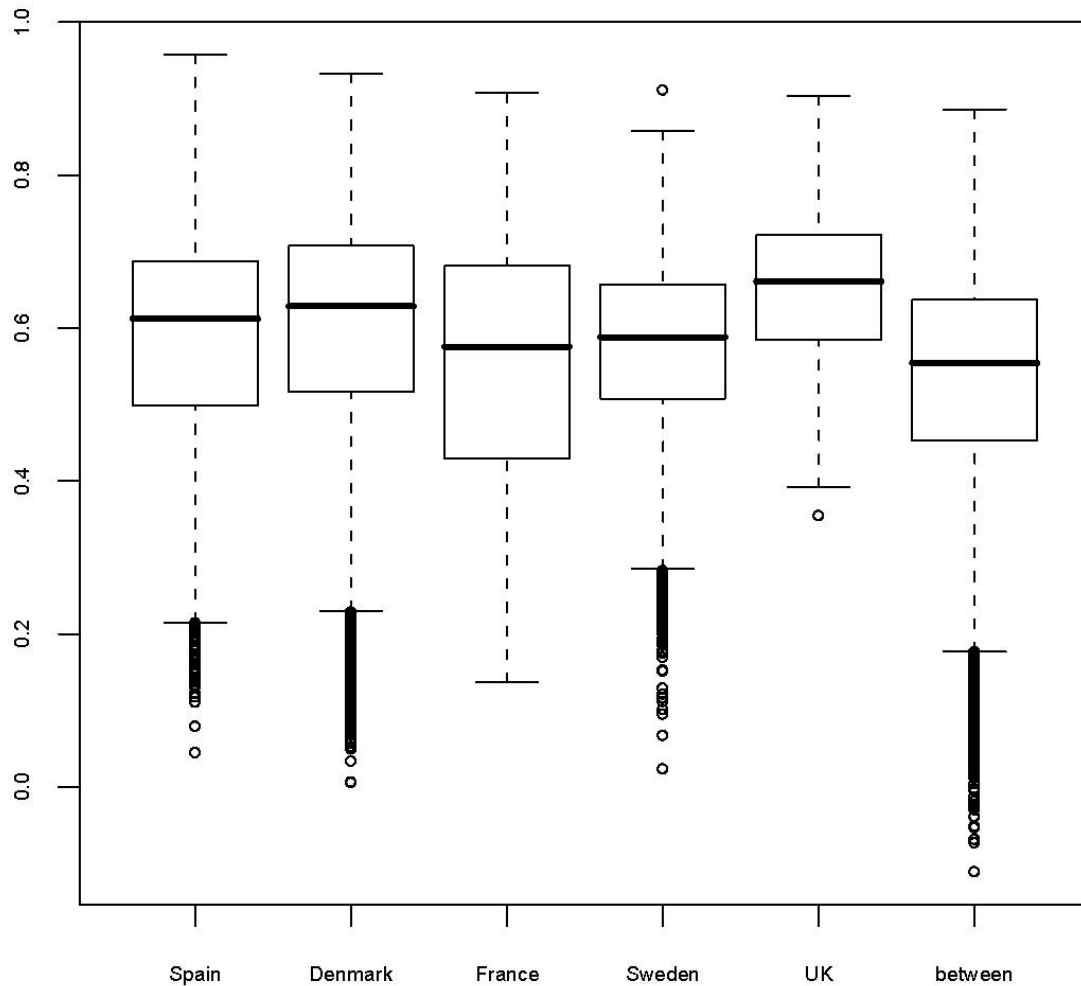


Supplementary Figure S1

Pearson Correlations between pairs of samples



Pearson correlation coefficients were calculated for each pair of samples. The results were summarized by boxplots depicting the distribution of the coefficients of the pairs of samples from each of the five countries (the first five boxes) and for pairs of samples from different countries (box 'between'). There is no striking difference between the distributions of correlations within and between countries.
